To answer a few questions you might have.....

Who we are...

The CRWGC is a women's 18 hole golf group and is a member of the Women's Public Links Golf Association (WPLGA). The Club is open to all women aged 18 yrs. or older.

Why we play...

Our goal is to ensure that women golfers enjoy the opportunity to improve their game, compete at all levels, display good sportsmanship, and make new friends.

When we play...

Our regular play day is every Thursday morning with tee times starting at 8:30 a.m. Once a month, we have a shotgun start at 9:00 a.m. with our golfers starting on different assigned holes. On shotgun days, we offer coffee and goodies from 8 a.m.-9:00 a.m. and encourage staying for lunch after golf.

What we play...

Each week our TCOM (Tournament Committee) representative offers us interesting and different competition in various golf formats. Once you have established a handicap, a \$3.00 fee for sweeps pool is collected prior to play. You may also join the yearly Birdie/Chip-In Pool.

In addition to regular weekly competition, there are several tournaments planned for the year:

Team Play –Match play competition against other clubs in the area. Anyone can play on the team once aWPLGA handicap has been established and they've played the required number of rounds . Players volunteer for the A,B, or C Teams according to their handicap. Team play is played on several pre-determined courses on each Monday in March, with the finals in April.

Club Championship –Stroke play competition. Entrants must be members with established handicaps and must have played The required number of rounds prior to the tournament.

President's Cup –Match play. Entrants must be members and have an established handicap. There is no required number of rounds to be played in order to participate.

Strawberry Fields -A special guest day. A great time to invite a friend from another club but it's not necessary to have a guest in order to play.

Rally for the Cure[®] -Our signature tournament benefitting the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation. All of our members are encourage to participate and to share their talents at this rewarding and fun-filled day.

How to sign up...

Sign up sheets are posted on our bulletin board for each week's play. If you do not have the opportunity to get to the Pro Shop, you can email the TCom Representative to sign up.

TCom sends out regular notices and reminders regarding the tee times and type of play for the day. TCom Representativess alternate each month so you will respond to whoever sends out the email.

How to get started...

To become a member, please fill out an application and return it with a check for \$50 to the Membership Chair.

If you do not currently have an established handicap, start saving your cards. You will be given a temporary handicap after 5 rounds, and a permanent one after 10 rounds.
