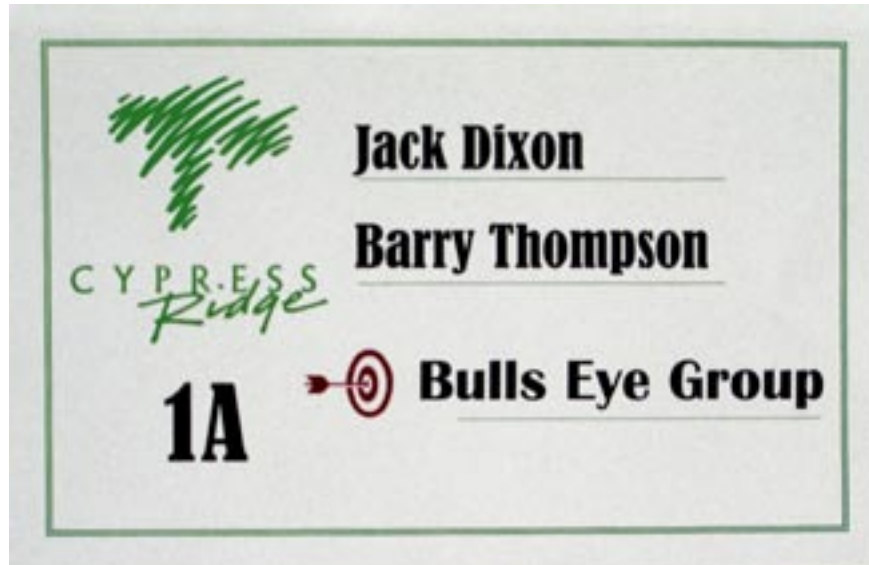

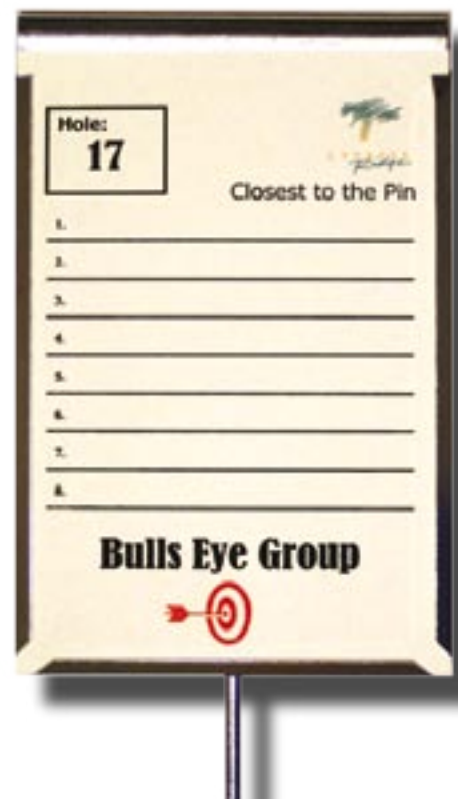

Directions to Golf Course:

From Hwy 101, from the South: Exit Hwy 101 at Los Berros Road, just north of Nipomo. Turn left and travel west about three miles. Turn left onto El Campo Rd. At next stop sign, turn left. Make first right at Cypress Ridge Parkway. Follow into parking lot and pro shop on the right.

From Hwy 101, from the North: Exit Hwy 101 at Halcyon Road in Arroyo Grande. Go straight at off ramp into Halcyon. Go through town and turn left at Hwy 1. Then make an immediate right back onto Halcyon. At the top of the hill go straight through the stop light. Continue straight through next stop sign. Make first right at Cypress Ridge Parkway. Follow into parking lot and pro shop on the right.
